Show Jumping from 10.30am

Members Points awarded to 6th place in regular classes.

Open to Horses & Ponies, rider any age

Class 1 - 50cm including Lead Rein, Rosettes to all. Not to have won 3 Classes at 50cm & above

Class 2 - 60cm including Lead Rein, Rosettes to all. Not to have won 3 Classes at 60cm & above

Class 3 - Pairs Jumping - 60cm. Both to jump 60cm in relay, passing a baton in a box

Class 4 - 70cm

Class 5 - Horse & Hound - A fun Class jumped at 70cm for Horses & a shortened course for Hounds on lead

Class 6 - 80cm

Class 7 - Pairs Jumping - 80cm. Both to jump 80cm in relay, passing a baton in a box

Class 8 - 90cm

Class 9 - 100cm

Mini Jumping from 10.00am

Combinations jumping in this ring may not jump in the main showjumping. Lead reins permitted in all classes

Rules & Conditions

All classes will be run in accordance with the latest BRC official rules.

Correctly fitted hard hats to CURRENT recognised British standard must be worn & securely fastened when mounted.

Body protectors are strongly recommended for jumping and under 16's

In public areas of the show ground horses/ponies must be ridden/led at walk.

Please respect the hospitality of the landowners & take your litter home/ use bins provided.

Do not clean out your horse box/trailer on the field.

The judge's decision is final & any objections must be handed to the secretary in writing with a £20 deposit, the deposit will be retained if the objection is not upheld.

Dogs must be kept on a short lead & under control at all times.

Horses & ponies must not be left unattended unless correctly secured inside the trailer/lorry.

Age as of January 1st 2018

Any horse/pony jumping as a horse/pony must do so for entire season.

Any person riding on a lead rein must do so for the rest of the event.

Non-members riding a member's horse must pay non-members entry fees.

No horse/pony under 4 years of age can be ridden on the show ground

Stallions by prior permission of the organiser and must display stallion discs

Refunds for withdrawals on the day will be subject to organisers discretion

Refunds for online pre entries in result of cancellation will be refunded minus a £2 admin charge

Legal Liability & Health, Safety & Welfare

No responsibility can be taken for theft, loss, damage, accident or illness caused to persons/animals/property or vehicles attending this event.

All persons attending must have their own 3rd party liability insurance if not a BRC member

The organisers of this event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. Class Information

RoR - Our Dressage and SJ classes will be RoR unaffiliated league qualifiers. Horses must have RoR competition membership.

RoR - All our classes will be points accumulators for RoR challenge rosettes. One will be awarded per show and Champion and Reserve Champion awarded at the end of season party for the most consistent horse. Horses must have RoR competition membership, and state this on entry form.
